

RADIO BILINGÜE PRIVACY POLICY

At Radio Bilingüe, we recognize the importance of privacy to visitors of our web site and services. This Privacy Policy explains what type of information is collected from you when you contact Radio Bilingüe or visit, register for or participate in the Radio Bilingüe Web site (the “Web Site”) and how that information may be used. Please note that this Privacy Policy is separate and distinct from the privacy policies governing any other Web site that may link to or from the Radio Bilingüe Web Site.

IMPLEMENTATION

Radio Bilingüe will implement this policy by designating a position within the agency to be responsible for the implementation of and adherence to this privacy policy; prominently posting the policy physically in its office and on its website; complying with the Information Practices Act (Civil Code Section 1798 et seq.), The Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.), Government Code Section 11015.5, and all other laws pertaining to information privacy laws, and using appropriate means to successfully implement and adhere to this privacy policy

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

RADIO BILINGÜE collects information that personally identifies you. Depending on your interaction with Radio Bilingüe and the Web Site, we may collect information such as your name, e-mail address, address, telephone number or credit card information. This information may be collected when you call in to a program or leave a message for producers on a call-in line or it may be requested when you register on the Web Site or for certain features it offers, when you submit or post a comment, message, story idea, photo, image or other content (“User Content”), when you make a donation or when you download or share information from the Web Site, and in other circumstances that may be specified at the time the information is collected.

USE OF THE INFORMATION

RADIO BILINGÜE uses the personally-identifying information for the following purposes: to manage and administer the Web Site; to respond to your messages; to identify you when you submit content; to process a donation; to communicate with you in our e-mails, newsletters, marketing and promotional communications or for other purposes that may be specified at the time the information is used.

We may post personal information that you disclose when you submit User Content such as a story, blog, image or photo to the Web Site, as well as the User Content itself, on the Web Site and it may become public.

With regard to User Content, RADIO BILINGÜE and its licensees do have the right to use, copy, sublicense, modify, transmit, publicly perform, display, create derivative works of, host, index, cache, tag, encode, and/or adapt any User Content in any and all media formats or channels, whether now known or hereafter devised, including, but not limited to, the Web Site, any member station Web sites, other third party web sites, over the air (on radio or television), and on mobile platforms, along with any personal information you have provided. We may print, broadcast or otherwise publish your User Content on the Web Site or on any broadcast or mobile platform along with any personal information that you have provided. Other users of the Web Sites may embed a widget or feed that allows your User Content to appear on their personal, noncommercial web site, blog or other application, along with the personal information you have provided, subject to conditions set forth in the Terms of Use.

We may disclose personal information if required to do so by law, e.g. in response to a subpoena or court order. We may also disclose your personal information at the request of a law enforcement agency or if we believe that it is necessary to protect against misuse or unauthorized use of the Web Site, to protect the personal safety or property of other users of the Web Site, the public or RADIO BILINGÜE and its employees or as otherwise required or permitted by law.

Other than for the preceding purposes, RADIO BILINGÜE does not use or share the information that personally identifies you. We sometimes use the non-personally identifiable information that we collect, and share it in aggregate form only with third parties, to improve the design and content of or to analyze usage of our broadcasts and the Web Site.

Security

We have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and help prevent unauthorized access, to maintain data security, and to use correctly the information we collect online.

Cookies

We do not set any cookies. If you do not want to receive e-mail from us in the future, please let us know by sending us e-mail at the above address.

UPDATES & EFFECTIVE DATE

From time to time, we may update this privacy statement. We will notify you about material changes in the way we treat personally identifiable information by placing a notice on our site. We encourage you to periodically check back and review this policy so that you always will know what information we collect, how we use it, and with whom we share it.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER

For international users, it is necessary for us to transfer your information internationally. In particular, your information will likely be transferred to and processed in the United

States. The data protection and other laws of other countries, such as the United States, may not be as comprehensive as those in your country. Please be assured that we take reasonable steps to ensure that your privacy is protected. By using this site you consent to your information being collected and used as set forth in this privacy statement.

CHILDREN

Children are not eligible to use services that require submission of personal information, and we require that minors (under the age of 18) do not submit any personal information to us. This includes submitting personal information to Radio Bilingüe as part of a user profile or personalization profile. If you are a minor, you can use these services only if used together with your parents or guardians. If you are a minor, you should seek guidance from your parents.

If Radio Bilingüe decides to begin collecting personal information from children, it will notify parents that it is being requested, disclose the reasons for collecting it, and disclose our intended use of it. Radio Bilingüe will seek parental consent before collecting any personally identifiable information. If it does collect it, parents may request information on the type of data being collected, view their child's information, and, if they choose, prohibit Radio Bilingüe from making further use of their child's information. Radio Bilingüe will not knowingly provide personal information about children to third parties.
